We carefully handcrafted this Castle Rock Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon from grapes that were harvested and blended from three vineyards in the Napa Valley, one of the World's most prestigious grape growing appellations.

Our Castle Rock Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon is a deliciously full wine loaded with nuance and flavor. It is a deep garnet in color, and has aromas of blackberries, cherry and cassis. On the palate it has supple tannins and flavors of ripe plum and dark fruit finishing with a hint of cedar. It makes an excellent accompaniment to beef, lamb, venison, and most cheeses.
